
DEAR COACHES, SPORTS LEADERS

INTRODUCTION

DEAR SPORTSLEADERS,
COACHES, AND COMPETITORS!



It is a great honor for us that we can host Budapest Open international competition for the 25th time. A quarter of a century ago the 1st Budapest Open only had around 150 registrations from 3 countries. From the 3rd year, we introduced Cadet and Junior categories, and from the 4th we also introduced the children's categories as well. Thanks to that, the number of registrations, and participating countries were skyrocketing each year. That's how we reached 2019 the last competition before the pandemic, which had over 2300 participants from 34 countries, and we had to close the registration 1 month before the event. Unfortunately in 2020 we had to cancel the event due to COVID. In 2021 we could host the event although with some restrictions.

For the 24th Budapest Open we had over 1700 registrations from 34 countries. Due to the steadily increasing number of participants more and more national karate federations make this event part of their qualification schedule. In 2021, 10 countries decided to do this, and thanks to that, in some senior categories the quality of participants rivaled that of Series A and Premier League.

We all hope, that by 2022 the COVID situation will stabilize, and nothing will stand in the way of us organizing a high quality event in Budapest. We also hope, that whoever has participated in the previous events, will return in the fall of 2022, and who haven't been here will take the chance to experience the event's great atmosphere, high standard, so they will be returning guests of us.

REGISTRATION:

16th September, from 17:00 until 22:00 at the Sport Hall,
weigh-in for all cadet, junior, U 21 and senior categories.

WEIGH IN:

17th September, from 07:00 until 13:00 at the Sport Hall,
also possibility for registration.

CATEGORIES:

Boys and girls in the following age and weight categories:

5-7 years old boys	-24 kg and +24 kg
5-7 years old girls	-22 kg and +22 kg
8-9 years old boys	-27 kg, -32 kg and +32 kg.
8-9 years old girls	-30 kg and +30 kg
10-11 years old boys	-30 kg, -35 kg, -40 kg, -45 kg and +45 kg
10-11 years old girls	-30 kg, -35 kg, -40 kg and +40 kg
12-13 years old boys	-40 kg, -45 kg, -50 kg, -55 kg and +55 kg
12-13 years old girls	-42 kg, -47 kg and +47 kg

Please consider the age of the competitors at the date of the tournament!

COMPETITION CATEGORIES: Individual kata and kumite.

RULES: WKF system - full repechage will be applied, with following changes: kata categories from 5 to 13 years old, 2 competitors perform the kata simultaneously, except for medal matches. In medal matches aka and au perform the kata separately.

1,5 minute for kumite age 5-13, 2 minutes for cadets.

KATA: age 5-7, 8-9, 10-11 - at least 2 different kata required
age 12-13 - at least 3 different kata required
cadets – WKF system. All categories full repechage!

REGISTRATION/WEIGH IN: 18th September from 07:00 until 12:00 at the Sport Hall. Weigh in is obligatory in cadet categories only. In children categories only the randomly selected few has to weigh-in. If the competitor is above the weight class by 1,5 kg in karate pants and t-shirt, he/she will be disqualified from the competition!

PROTECTION: Gum shields, WKF type red and blue mitts, shin pads and foot protection, for women chest protection over 12 years are mandatory.

ENTRY FEE: 25 Euro each category, 35 Euro Open category, 40 Euro team kumite category.

PRIZES: 1-3 places: medals and certificates, the winner of each category will receive a cup.

ALLOWED WAYS TO DOUBLE START: It is possible to start in kata and kumite in the same age category, but it's not possible to start in kumite in the same age category in different weight classes. For example: kumite cadet male -52 kg can compete in kumite junior male -55 kg, but not in cadet kumite -52 kg and cadet -57 kg! In kata categories it is only possible to start in 2 categories. For example: cadet male and junior male or U 21 and senior.

DRAW: 16th September, 2022.

PROTEST: The protest has to be submitted in writing to the referee council of the tournament and 100 Euro protest fee has to be deposited. If the protest is accepted by the referee council, the fee is going to be refunded.

REFEREES: Referees are going to be delegated by the Hungarian Karate Federation. Foreign qualified referees are welcome. Please, apply in writing to nominate your referee!

RESPONSIBILITY: The organization committee will not bear any responsibility of any kinds of damages or losses.

ATTENTION: All competitors must have their own red and blue belts.
